




Today's Passage

John 8:31-36 Then said Jesus to those Jews who believed on him, If you continue in my word, then are you my disciples indeed; And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. They answered him, We are Abraham's descendants, and were never in bondage to any man: how say you, You shall be made free? Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever commits sin is the servant of sin. And the servant abides not in the house forever: but the Son abides ever. If the Son therefore shall make you free, you shall be free indeed.

4 Elements

John 8:31-32 Then said Jesus to those Jews who believed on him, If you continue in my word, then are you my disciples indeed; And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

Freedom

John 8:33 They answered him, We are Abraham's descendants, and were never in bondage to any man: how say you, You shall be made free?

The bondage of sin

John 8:34 Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever commits sin is the servant of sin.

Jesus' Offer

John 8:35-36 And the servant abides not in the house forever: but the Son abides ever. If the Son therefore shall make you free, you shall be free indeed.

The Context

 This teaching comes right after the restoration of the woman caught in adultery for a reason

Other passages

Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty with which Christ has made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.


What is Freedom?

- Not the freedom to do whatever we want to do
- But the spiritual freedom that Jesus offers
 - Freedom from evil spirits
 - Freedom from the consequences of our sin
 - Freedom that comes when we know our identity and secure future

Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them who are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
