

The Gospel in One Night

Our Text



Sharing the Good News


Luke 2:17 And when they had seen it, they made known abroad the saying which was told them concerning this child.

Transformation


Luke 2:20 And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them.

• What Jesus did in and to the shepherds He wants to do in and to us as well



• Christmas should remind us to seek an encounter God's Glory




• Christmas should remind us of the great gifts we have in Jesus




• Christmas should remind us to leave certain things of this world behind




• Christmas should remind us to worship God




• Christmas should remind us to be transformed by Jesus
