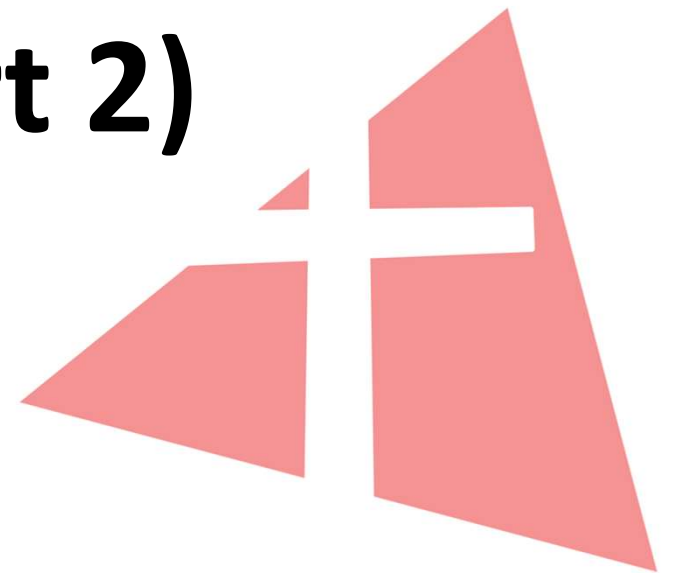

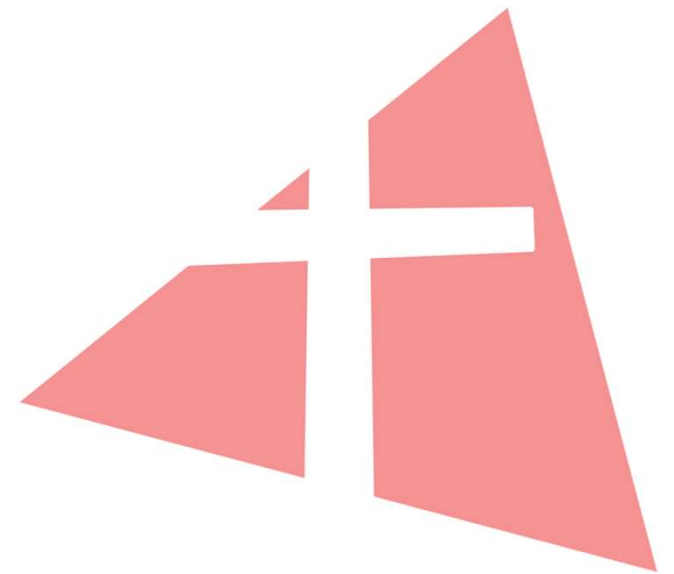

Lord, Master

- Adonai (Lord, Master, ' אֲדֹנָי Adonay ad-o-noy')
- Often (but not exclusively) used as “My Lord”
 - General acknowledgement
 - Personal decision

Psalms 38:9 Lord, all my desire is before you; and my groaning is not hid from you. ”



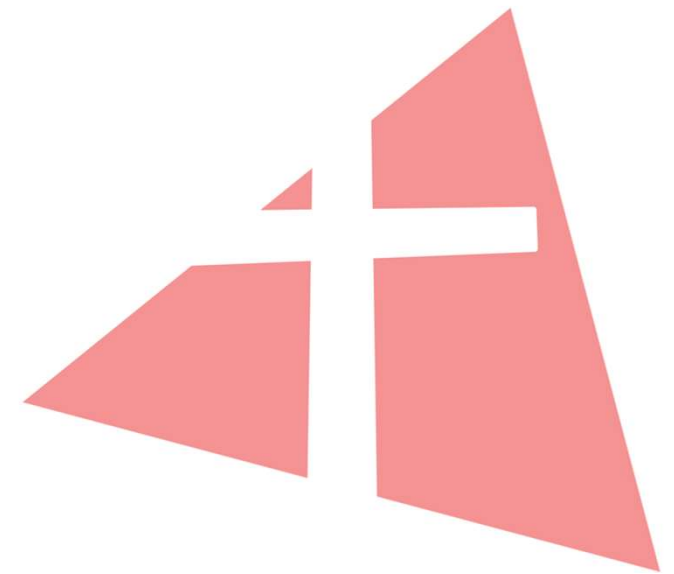
Lord, Master

Psalms 51:15 O Lord, open my lips; and my mouth shall show forth your praise.



Lord, Master

- **When should we address God as Adonai?**
 - Reminding ourselves that God is Lord over everything
 - Making Him Lord over our lives again
 - Reason to praise and worship God again

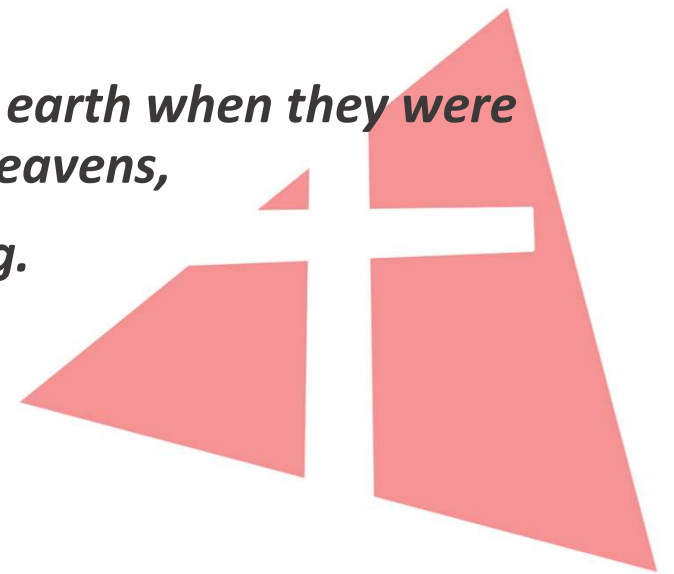


The Self-Existent One

- Yahweh (LORD, Yehovah, יהוה־י@hovah yeh-ho-vaw')

Genesis 2:4 These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens,

Psalms 2:11 Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling.



The Self-Existent One

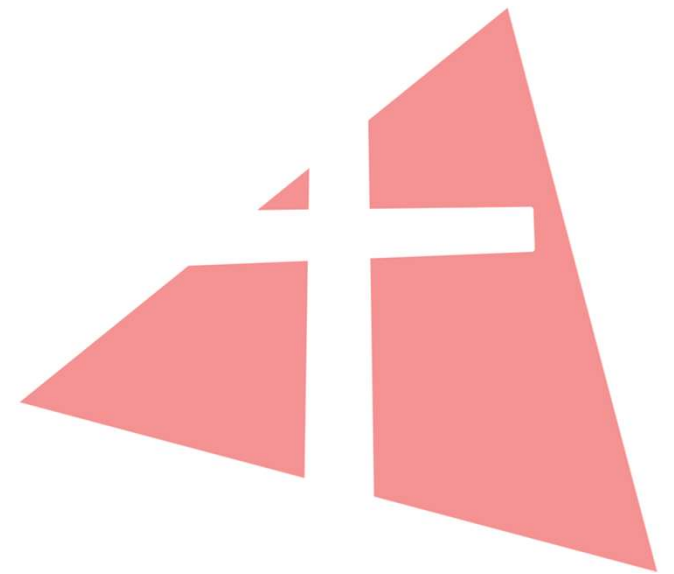
Psalms 50:1 The mighty God, even the LORD, has spoken, and called the earth from the rising of the sun unto the going down thereof.

Psalms 50:12 If I were hungry, I would not tell you: for the world is mine, and the fulness thereof.



The Self-Existent One

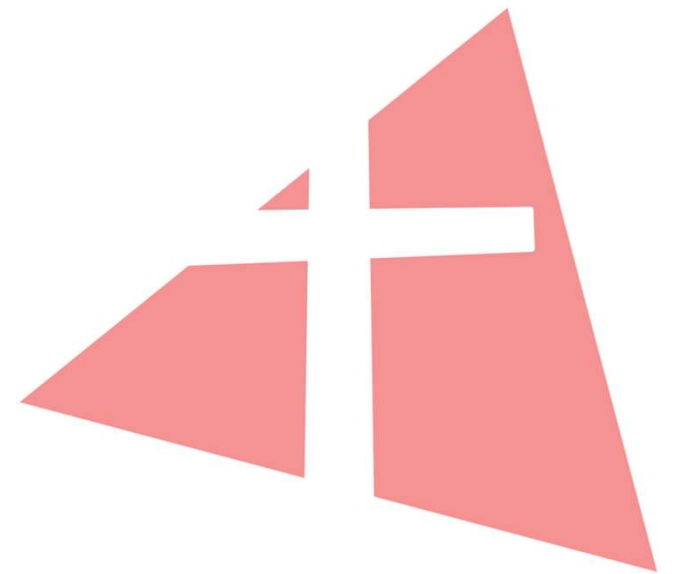
- **When should we relate to God as Yahweh?**



The Lord is my shepherd

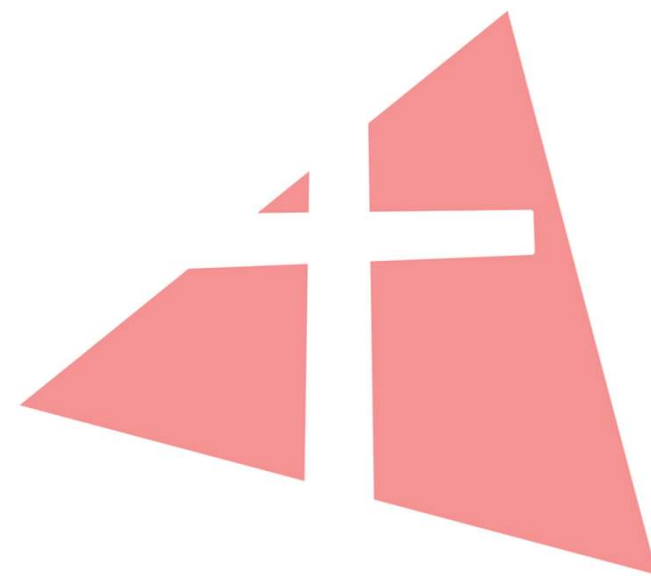
○ Jehowah-Raah (The Lord is my shepherd, יהוה ראה ra`ah raw-aw')

Psalms 23:1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

The Lord Who Heals

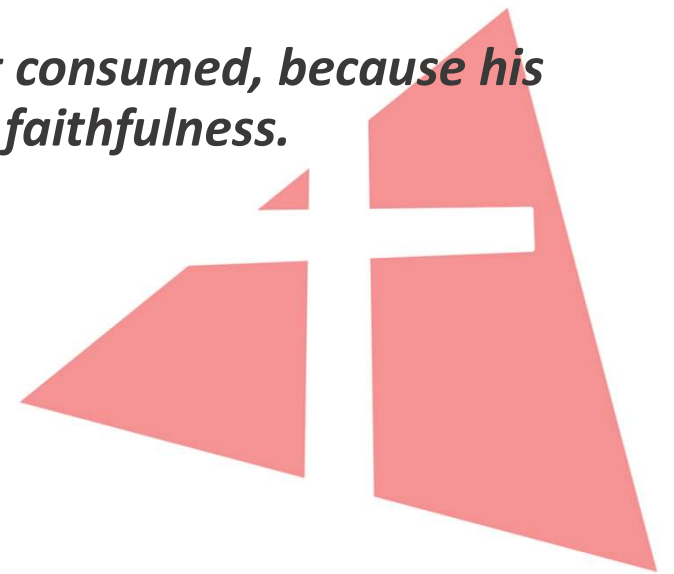
- Jehovah-Rapha (The Lord who Heals, אֲפֹרָפָה 'raw-faw')

Exodus 15:26 And said, If you will diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD your God, and will do that which is right in his sight, and will give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon you, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that heals you.



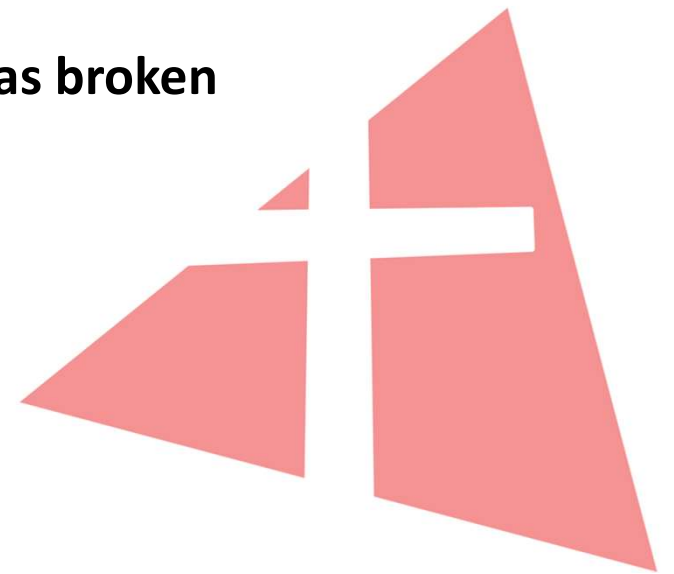
The Lord Who Heals

Lamentations 3:22-23 It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is your faithfulness.



The Lord Who Heals

- **When should we relate to God as our Jehovah-Rapha?**
- **When the require healing and restoration for things that sin has broken**
 - God won't always answer the way we expect
 - But He will always heal and restore



The Lord Will Provide

- Jehovah-Jireh (The Lord will provide, יְהוָה יִרְאֶה @hovah yireh yehho-vaw' yir-eh')

Genesis 22:14 And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovahjireh: as it is said to this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen.



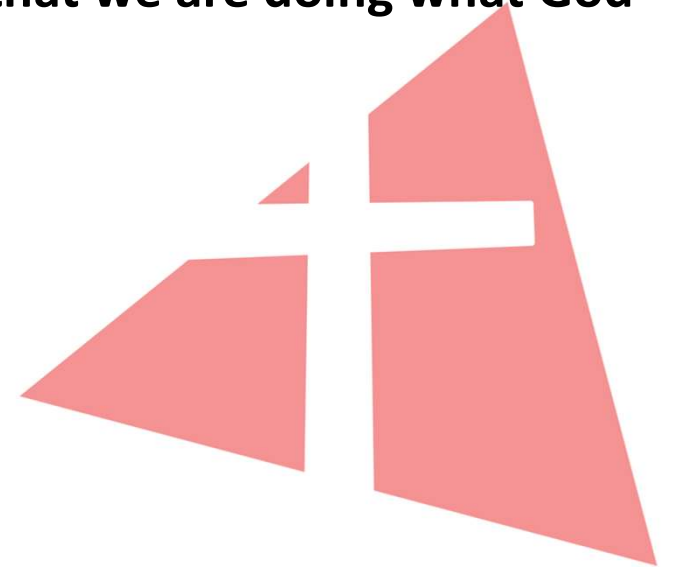
The Lord Will Provide

- **God will provide for**
 - whatever He expects us to give to Him
 - whatever we need
- **We don't need to come up with it ourselves**



The Lord Will Provide

- **Our security concerning provisions must come from knowing that we are doing what God wants us to do**
 - Not trying to provide for ourselves
 - When we do God's will, He will provide for all our needs



The Lord Will Provide

- **When should we relate to God as our Jehovah-Jireh?**
 - When we are running out of our own resources



A Reminder

- **We can't simply pick one name we like and stop there**
- **We need to get a balanced view of "Who God is"**
