

Lord, Master

- o Adonai (Lord, Master, ' אֲדֹנֶיAdonay ad-o-noy')
- Often (but not exclusively) used as "My Lord"
 - General acknowledgement
 - Personal decision

Psalms 38:9 Lord, all my desire is before you; and my groaning is not hid from you."


Lord, Master

• When should we address God as Adonai?

- Reminding ourselves that God is Lord over everything
- Making Him Lord over our lives again
- Reason to praise and worship God again

Psalms 2:11 Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling.


The Self-Existent One



The Lord is my shepherd


o Jehowah-Raah (The Lord is my shepherd, בֶּעָה a`ah raw-aw')

The Lord Who Heals

o Jehovah-Rapha (The Lord who Heals, רֶפָא rapha' raw-faw')

Exodus 15:26 And said, If you will diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD your **God**, and will do that which is right in his sight, and will give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon you, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that heals you.

The Lord Who Heals

Lamentations 3:22-23 It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is your faithfulness.


The Lord Who Heals

- When should we relate to God as our Jehovah-Rapha?
- When the require healing and restoration for things that sin has broken
 - God won't always answer the way we expect
 - But He will always heal and restore

o Jehovah-Jireh (The Lord will provide, יְהֹנָה יִרְאֵה Y@hovah yireh yehho-vaw' yir-eh')


Genesis 22:14 And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovahjireh: as it is said to this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen.

- God will provide for
 - whatever He expects us to give to Him
 - whatever we need
- We don't need to come up with it ourselves




- Our security concerning provisions must come from knowing that we are doing what God wants us to do
 - Not trying to provide for ourselves
 - When we do God's will, He will provide for all our needs

- When should we relate to God as our Jehovah-Jireh?
 - When we are running out of our own resources



A Reminder

- We can't simply pick one name we like and stop there
- We need to get a balanced view of "Who God is"
