




John 13:35 By this shall all men know that you are my disciples, if you have love one to another.


#### An analogy

1 Corinthians 13:5 ... seeks not her own...




## **Evangelism**

o If we love people in order to get something back from them, it's not Biblical love


# **Practical examples**
